## A word from our community

“When I first came to the office, I was in the middle of a painful divorce and felt like my life was falling apart. Everything felt overwhelming, and I didn’t know how I would take care of myself and my children.

But I wasn’t alone. My caseworker sat with me step by step, helping me apply for benefits. He explained everything, helped fill out the paperwork, and made sure I understood my options. For the first time in months, I felt like someone was in my corner.

On my hardest days, he reminded me that I was stronger than my circumstances. That support changed everything. Because of it, I’m still standing, rebuilding, and finally feel like I have a future again.”

## Our Outreach Team

Combining a deep, trauma-informed understanding of the local social services landscape with a real-world, problem-solving approach, our outreach case workers connect families to a variety of impactful resources across Morris County.

We assisted over 1,000 neighbors get connected to services or apply for benefits including:

- Applications for public benefits
- Individualized bilingual case management and help with resource navigation
- Resume and employment assistance
- Mental and physical health referrals
- Financial and credit guidance
- Steady and empathetic advocacy



nourish.NJ relies on our non-profit partners to bring the most needed services on site for our neighbors, providing more than 85 on site visits in 2025.

## In addition to providing direct services,

nourish.NJ addresses the root causes of hunger and poverty through thoughtful, nonpartisan advocacy. Grounded in our daily work, we elevate the voices of our guests and staff to inform policymakers, funders, and community leaders about barriers to food access, housing, healthcare, and public benefits. Through coalition work, public education, and partnerships, nourish.NJ advances policies that strengthen the social safety net and create pathways to long term stability.

## No one does it alone

Our dedicated volunteers are the heart of nourish.NJ, generously giving their time and talents to ensure that every neighbor is welcomed with dignity, care, and compassion. This year, individuals, community organizations, and corporate partners contributed:

- 7,400 volunteer shifts
- 14,000 volunteer hours
- Value over \$320,000
